Since 1986, Heinfeld has lead the design direction of the firm resulting in more than 135 design awards from the American Institute of Architects (AIA) on national, state and local platforms. More than 80 percent of LPA's work has received a design award during Heinfeld's tenure. His project highlights include the Environmental Nature Center in Newport Beach, the first LEED Platinum building in Orange County; Toyota South Campus in Torrance; and the North American Headquarters for Ford Motor Company in Irvine.
