CALBO REPORT BY JAY ELBETTAR

- Newport Beach is recruiting for a plan check engineer.
- City of Phoenix recently approved the adoption of the IBC over the NFPA by a vote of 6-3.
- Initial draft of the IRC by HCD is posted on their website.
- Recent appointees by the Governor of California:
 - Lucy Dunn as the director of HCD.
 - Dale Geldert as the director of the Department of Forestry and Fire Protection.
 - Ruben Grijalva as the State Fire Marshal.
- On June 28, the American Forest and Paper Association sent a letter to NFPA denying the release of their documents.
- The ISO issue will be on the Calbo board agenda for tomorrow's meeting.
- There will be two openings on the ICC board. Calbo received a request for support from Kevin Scott and John Latorra.
- Calbo is developing an education evaluation criteria program to allow people to work and participate in our education program and is subject to review by the Calbo board tomorrow.
- This year's Calbo training session in Ontario is from November 1 – 5.
- Steve Ikkanda reminded the group of next week's BSC meeting. Jay indicated on the agenda for that meeting in Sacramento is a proposal to adopt the NEC independent from the adoption of the rest of the construction codes. Andrew Adelman described the disadvantages of adopting codes at different times and moved for a motion for each Chapter to write a letter to the BSC to oppose that proposal. The motions were approved by both Chapters.

must take the initial exam again**

REINSTATEMENT - Complete CEU requirements, three year term begins again when you renew

Oversight for the ICC Certification Program is provided by BIPS

**BOARD FOR INTERNATIONAL PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS (BIPS)
A Committee of Building Officials which Reports to the ICC BOD**

ICC CERTIFICATION RENEWAL

- ▶ **Participate in Continuing Education and Professional Development Program Activities**
- ▶ **Accrue the required number of CEUs during a three year period**
- ▶ **Complete the Renewal Application**

CEUs required per application

1 certificate:	1.5 CEUs
2 certificates:	3.0 CEUs
3 or more certificates:	4.5 CEUs
1 or more Special Insp certs:	2.5 CEUs
C.B.O. certificate:	4.5 CEUs

How to accrue CEUs

Employment, for the immediate past 3 years prior to renewing, as a building official, plans examiner, permit technician or inspector. 1.0 CEU for the three year period.

Attend or teach a seminar or technical session delivered by ICC, model code organization or chapter, related professional society, state code enforcement licensing agency or standards-writing organization, or any related federally sponsored program. 0.1 CEU for each clock hour of attendance.

Attend or teach a class at an accredited academic institution. 1.0 CEU for each academic credit hour.

Successful completion of a self-study course offered by a model code organization, state code enforcement licensing agency or accredited academic institution. 1.0 CEU per course.

Attendance at code development hearings. Not to exceed 2.0 CEUs annually.

Committee or board service to ICC, model code organization or chapter for 1 year. Not to exceed 1.0 CEU annually.

Obtaining a new ICC certification by taking & passing the initial proctored exam. 0.5 CEU per certification.

Preparing for and taking an initial ICC certification exam but receiving an unsuccessful score. 0.1 CEU per exam

Participate in the Online Renewal Update program. 0.5 CEU per Online Renewal Update
