- ☐ A question by Jeff Murphy in San Diego regarding declination of ISO surveys was posed via email to which Tony Elmo in Temecula responded that they intended to decline a survey until a code is adopted in California which does not cause ISO to start by deducting 9 out of 10 points. It is interesting to note that declination is an option and may be an approach shared by others.
