PBLC 079 – **Sustainable Living and Green Building Programs (1 Unit)**

Mondays 6:00 to 10:15pm, January 24 – February 14, 2011 - Room E

Prerequisite: none

Provides introduction to various Green Building programs such as 2010 CA. Green Building Standards Code (CALGREEN), LEED, Build it Green, CA. Green Builder and ICC700 Standards Building Code. Provide an understanding of current regulations in energy-efficient building design and a solid base for careers in building, construction and utilities. This course is recommended for the general public and students, architects, project managers, building energy modelers, inspectors, consultants and contractors interested in Green environmental studies. This course will explore concepts such as; building carbon foot print, cap and trade and future Green economy.

PBLC 078 – **Building Dept. Administration and Code Enforcement (2 Units)**

Mondays 6:00 to 10:00pm, March 28 – May 16, 2011 - Room E

Prerequisite: none

Overview the building planning and entitlement process, permitting, municipal regulation administration and enforcement. Responsibilities of the Community Development and Building Department staff are explored. Focus on the day-to-day operations of the building department, duties of building official, building inspectors, technicians and code enforcement staff. This course is recommended for those interested in pursuing a development project in local cities or career in a building department as a permit technician, inspector, code compliance officer or code enforcement personnel.

Classes will be taught by City of Orange staff. Either CEU (continuing education units) or college credits are available. No books are required for this class; handouts will be provided by the instructor. Pre-register with Santiago Canyon College online at www.sccollege.edu.
