The ICC Orange Empire Chapter represents 35 jurisdictions in the Southern California region. Established back in 1958, our membership has been active and is very familiar with the code adoption process.

On October 15, 2009 during its scheduled monthly business meeting, the ICC Orange Empire Chapter unanimously voted to support the Emergency Regulations of Chapter 16A titled "NONPOTABLE WATER REUSE SYSTEMS" (Graywater Systems) and the adoption of the 2010 Codes proposed by HCD; but, recommends the attached amendments be included as part of the proposed language. The motion that was passed stated the following:

"ICC Orange Empire Chapter strongly recommends amending the Emergency Regulations titled "NONPOTABLE WATER REUSE SYSTEMS" (Graywater Systems) and the adoption of the 2010 codes proposed by HCD and fully supports the inclusion of the attached amendments."
