This course is designed for building owners, facility managers and design teams who are interested in implementing the LEED® for Existing Buildings 2.0 Rating System, and includes references to the new LEED® for Existing Building Operations & Maintenance 2.2 Rating System. Facilities upgrades, reducing building operating costs, solving building operation problems, improving indoor environment, and supporting higher productivity of building occupants will be covered. This workshop goes beyond the basics of the LEED® for Existing Buildings v2.0 Rating System, using case studies and exercises to provide an overview of the building certification process. This course is also an excellent start for those preparing for the LEED Accreditation Professional exam in the Existing Buildings track, although it does not guarantee a passing score.
